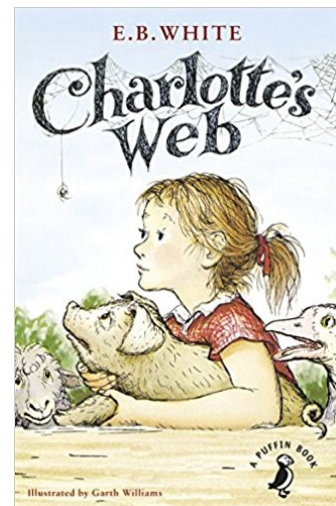

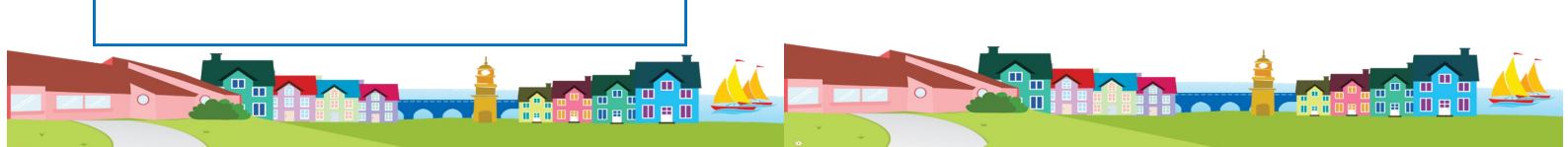

English
