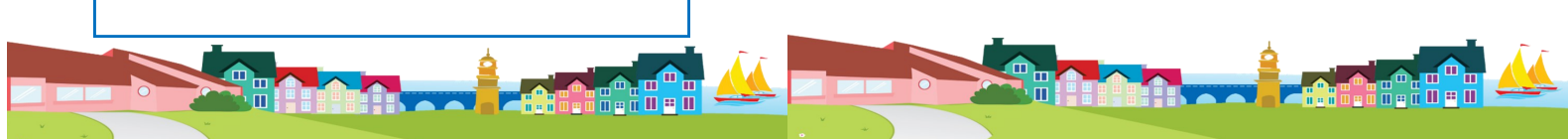
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Topic coverage (this may change during the term)

English

- We will be learning key spelling patterns through Read Write Inc.

- We will also be looking at biographies and non-fiction texts.

Mathematics: WALT:

- Add and subtract numbers to 20.
- Learning multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
- Place value of numbers to 50.
- Measuring and comparing lengths.
- Measuring weight and volume.

Art

- Learning how to create different colours and textures.
