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Topic coverage (this may change during the term)

English

- We will be learning key spelling patterns through Read Write Inc.
- We will be reading and retelling a range of fiction texts including 'Monkey Puzzle'.
- We will be reading non-fiction texts about the jungle.
- We will also be reading poetry about the jungle including 'Rumble in the Jungle'.

Art

 Use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination

Physical Education

- We will be continuing to develop our basic skills through Real PE.
