Starting School Information **Reception**

- Staggered Entry
- Start date: Monday 7th September
Children will attend a shorter settling in session either in the morning or the afternoon
- 8th and 9th September Children will attend longer settling in sessions either in the morning or afternoon
- 10th September whole cohort full morning and lunch
- 11th September whole cohort full day
- Week beginning 14th September, all children full time



Food/Drink Reception

- Please provide a labelled bottle containing water each day
- Fruit/vegetable snack is provided by the school every day
- Milk is provided through the Cool Milk Scheme
- School Meals are provided free of charge – need to be ordered via Parent Pay
