Any spare change to fill your class bottle would be greatly appreciated - all money raised will be used on the children around Christmas time. The class who raises the most will get an extra treat !

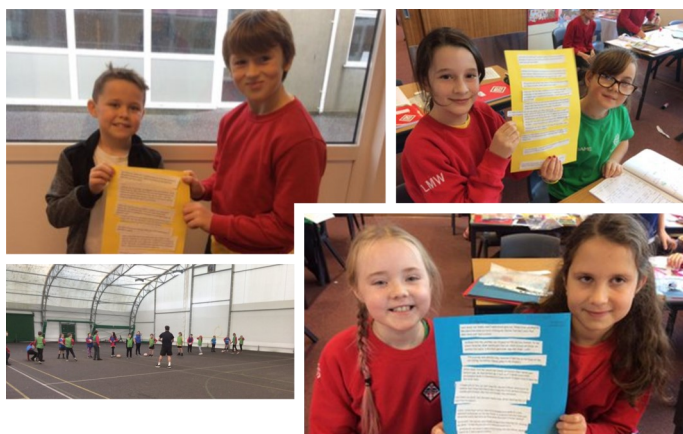


## Celebrating Learning
