After a comprehensive submission & assessment by a Trauma & Mental Health-Informed Schools (TMHIS) assessor, Penryn Primary Academy is the 1st primary school in England to be awarded the prestigious TMHIS Award!

The award recognises the high standard of inclusion practice demonstrated by Penryn staff, in supporting adults and children with trauma and mental health difficulties. The aim is for all 28 Aspire academies to achieve this recognised status by 2022.

Susan Costello, Director of Inclusion for the Trust, comments, "We are delighted for the entire Penryn community and sincerely thank all staff at the academy as well as Julie Harmieson, TMHIS leader for the Aspire Lead Inclusion Team, for their dedication and hard work in achieving this award.

Its aim is to provide appropriate training for schools, communities, and organisations so that they become trauma-informed and mentally healthy places for all.
