Take a look at some of the wonderful learning taking place in school this week....

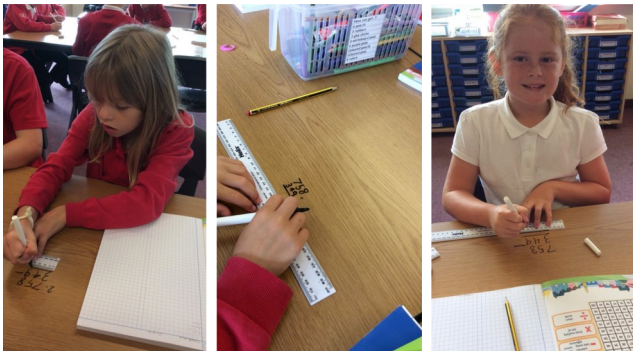


A massive welcome to our new reception children! They are all settling in so well, which is lovely to see!
