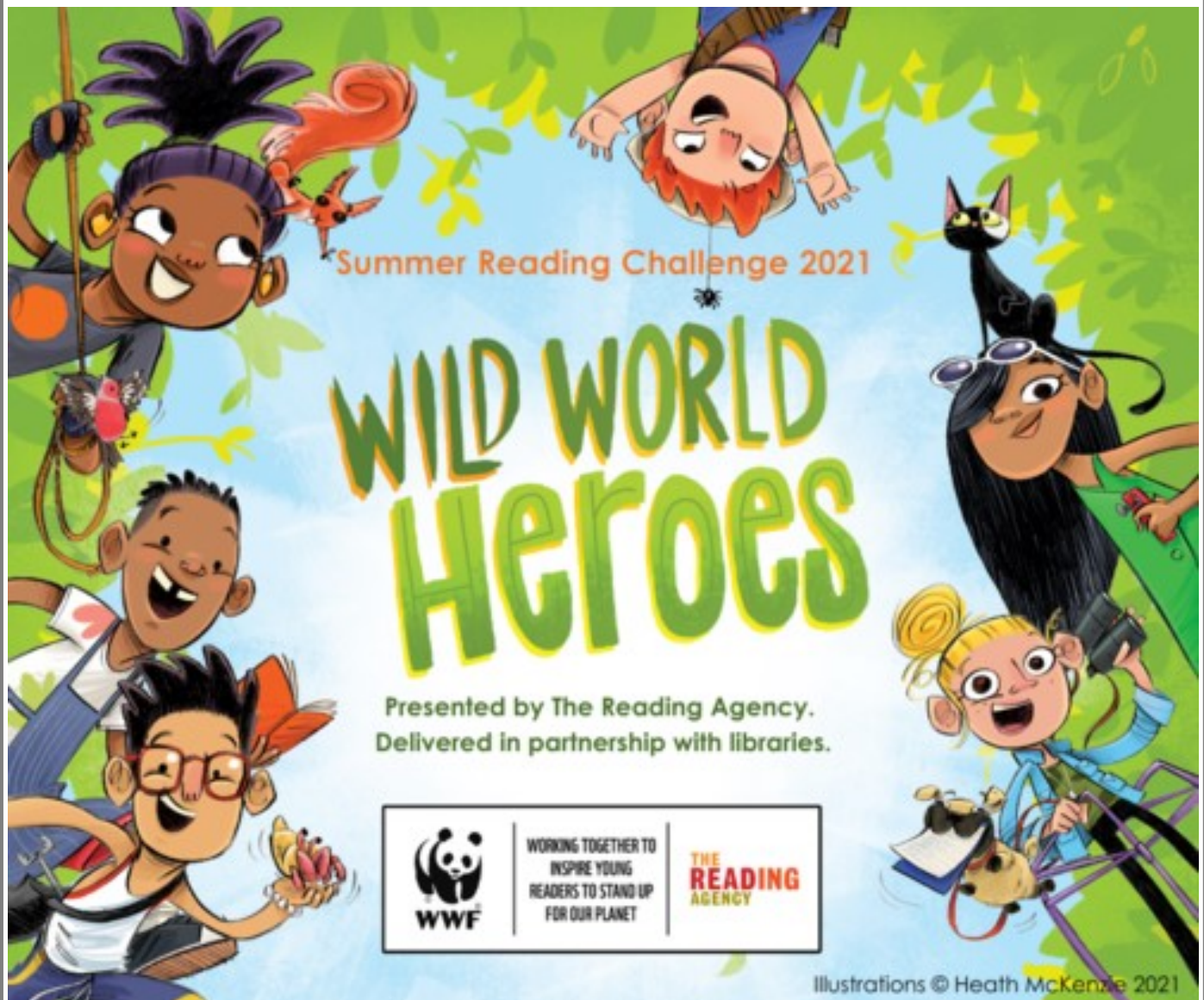
Swimming
